Basketball – a Popular American Sport

One of the most popular sports in the United States is basketball. It is the only major sport that is completely American in origin.

James A. Naismith, a physical education teacher, invented the game in the early 1890s. The game quickly spread in the United States and then all over the world.

Basketball is played between two teams of five players each on a rectangular court. At each end of the court is a basket, or goal, that is suspended from a backboard. The player with possession of the ball must pass or bounce the ball to a position from where he or a teammate tries to put it in the basket. Any player may shoot at the basket. Points ranging from one to three are awarded for successful throws. Professional teams play four 12-minute periods with a 20-minute rest between the second and third periods.
